NOTICE TO HORSE EVENT COMPETITORS

Competitors must complete the following:

- 1. Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration** – must be completed prior to competition and given to Chief Steward before entering the ring.
- 2. Indemnity form - WAIVER** – can be completed online or given to Chief Steward.
One per competitor.
- 3. Camping & Stable MUST BE PAID FOR BEFORE COMPETING.** Stall and camping will be allocated on a first in basis with preference given to traveling competitors. Camping will be 'loosely' allocated to accommodate as many competitors as possible, please see / call the Chief Steward on your arrival to be directed to your site.
- 4. Dressage Nominations** – completed online. Nominations close 6th June.

Camping and Access to the Grounds

Limited camping for Horse Section competitors will be available on the grounds near the undercover stables and stallion stables. There will be no camping near the cattle section. All other camping will be outside of the grounds along Station Street. There are water and power access points available along this street.

Camping will incur a cost of \$50 for the entire show and come with 2 complementary competitor passes and is available from Wednesday to 12 noon Sunday. Free camping is available at the Equestrian Centre.

Note: One car & float or truck combo per camp site. Please check the chief steward for directions where to camp. We would hate to have to ask you to move.

Additional competitor passes are at the discounted rate of \$10 per adult children are \$5 each. Your wristbands are available from the Chief Steward and must always be worn as security will be checking people for valid entry.

The Station Street gates will be open from Friday from 7.30 am to 6.30 pm on Friday and 7.30 am to 8 pm on Saturday night. Entry through Station Street outside of these times can be arranged by contacting the Chief Steward on Ph 0427 958 426. Security will be on the grounds over the show.

Nominations:	Entry to classes will be by ticket system and can be pre-purchased online. Tickets can also be purchased at the Stewards marquee.
Dressage Nominations:	Closing date 6th June 2022 – tests available from Horse Section cloncurryshow

Prize money will not be paid to any person other than the winners. Uncollected prize money will not be forwarded. Tied place getters shall present together for payment of prize money.

Regulations Applying to Horse Section

1. Competitors will not be eligible until the full entry fee and all outstanding monies have been paid in full.
2. All entries must be accompanied by correct entry fee. No refunds will be given except in exceptional circumstances.
3. All jumping contests will be judged under PCAQ rules.
4. A Maiden is determined to be a horse that has never won a blue ribbon at any Agricultural Show at the time of nominations.
5. A Novice is determined to be a horse that has never won an Open Championship at any Agricultural Show at the time of nominations.
6. Pony Hack shall be under 14hh. Ponies under 12.2 hands must be ridden by riders under 17 years. Ponies 12.2 hands and over can be ridden by an adult rider, unless otherwise stated.
7. Galloway Hack shall be 14hh not exceeding 15hh.
8. Hack shall be 15hh and over.
9. Ladies and gent riders will be 17 years and over.
10. Pleasure Hack classes must be ridden in a plain snaffle, no spurs, whips or dropped nose bands.
11. Novice hacks must be novices at the time of starting (IE, have not won a maiden class at any show).
12. District means Shire of Cloncurry and all adjoining local authorities. Horse and rider must reside in district for a period of six months prior to show. Local events are for residents and horses of Cloncurry and McKinlay Shire only who have resided in Cloncurry and McKinlay Shire for the previous 6 months.
13. Dressage competitors may ride no more than two horses in each test. Horses must be ridden by one rider only in each test.
14. Prize winners in all sections are requested to participate in the Grand Parade (Supreme Champion Hack, Supreme Champion Rider and Champion Junior Competitor of the show awards and prizes will be present at the grand parade. A lucky gate ticket will put you in the draw to win \$100 for entering.
15. Competitors nominated in two rings where times clash must make a choice of which event they are to compete in and, except for championships, events will not be held up for late riders under any circumstances. Delays may occur throughout the show to accommodate other entertainment in the ring that may cause upset or danger to horses and or riders.
16. Competitors enter at their own risk. Entries will only be accepted on condition that the show society is not held responsible for any accident or damage by or to any exhibit and the exhibitors shall accept all responsibility in this respect.
17. No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor (including one handler in children led hack events) and those having official or requested duties to perform.
18. All riders and attendants must be suitably attired.
19. The committee reserves the right to alter the program.
20. Registration papers must be made available on request, if necessary, e.g., led and specified ridden classes
21. Stewards have full authority to refuse nominations that do not comply with residential or other conditions as stated in the schedule.
22. Stallions will only be eligible to compete in stallion classes, dressage, jumping, working stock horse, western and novelty events by riders 17yrs & over.
23. All stallions 2 years and over must have a bit in their mouth and be controlled by a person 17yrs and over.
24. All stock must undergo health tests to comply with individual property status and be free of cattle ticks.
25. Any other breed unregistered means THAT NO horse or pony with financial affiliation to any associated organization may enter.
26. No person shall act as judge except for classes in which he, himself, is not an exhibitor.
27. Judges will have the power to withhold prizes and champion honors at their discretion if they believe no entrant has merit or an entrant is unsound.
28. Should an exhibitor, having gained a prize, be disqualified, the next in merit shall gain the prize.
29. In awarding championships, the judges will be required to select the next animal or rider in order of merit, to be called 'Reserve' which may, if the judge's consent, become the Champion in the event of the Champion being disqualified for any reason.
30. If any disputes arise for which no specific rule is provided, the committee reserves the right to determine the matter.
31. Birth dates of the riders on the first day shall be considered as the date of birth for the duration of the show.
32. All horses/ponies and stallions must be free from contagious diseases.
33. All horse/pony to mean mare, filly, and gelding.
34. Any exhibit, not under control in the opinion of the judge or stewards, will not be judged and will be ordered to leave the ring and warm up areas.
35. Helmet standards must be adhered to.
36. No drug, hormone or tranquilizer shall be administered to any animal exhibit except under the direction of a vet who shall advise the stewards if such drug, hormone, or tranquilizer is likely to have any effect upon the animal which would be material to its chances of being awarded a prize and in such case the stewards may debar the animal from competing. A steward may at any time direct the vet to take a sample of blood, saliva, or urine from an exhibit for testing. Drug testing may be performed on any horse/pony or stallion.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES ARE HORSES TO BE LED/ RIDDEN ONTO THE NEW OVAL. HORSE AND RIDERS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED IF THIS OCCURS. PLEASE RESPECT THE COUNCIL WISHES THAT NO HORSE ENTERS THE ARENA.

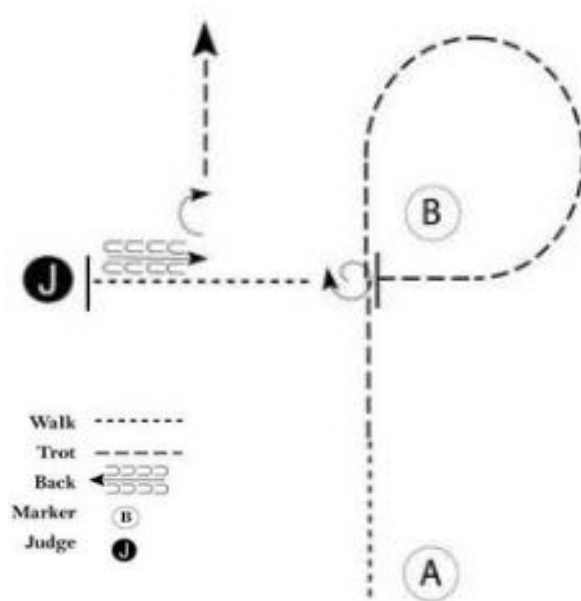
